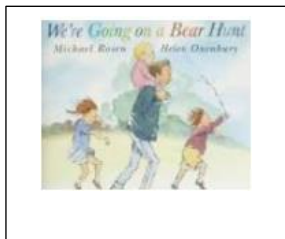


Nursery- November to December 2023

This term the children will begin to bring story books home to share at home. Could you please provide a book bag/back pack or your child.

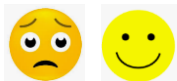


The children will play inside and outside, exploring the different areas. They will discover exciting things to do! They will learn how to share and play with or alongside other children.
