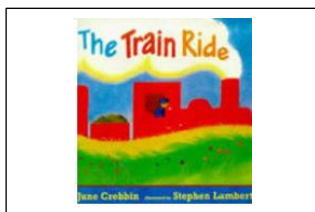


Nursery- February-March 2024

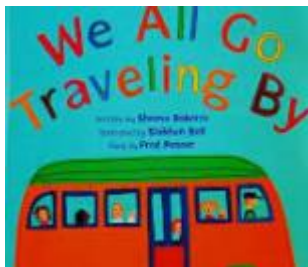
A long and winding road

Please log into Tapestry, an online learning journal that we use to record the learning and fun your children have in nursery. If you have any questions about this, please ask Miss Rigg.



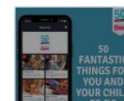
We will be encouraging the children to talk about the journeys they have made and about the places they have visited. We will develop a 'ticket office' for the children to pretend to buy tickets for long or short journeys and to develop and use their imagination to go to spectacular destinations!



We are planning a nursery trip to go on a train ride towards the end of this term or early next term. Very exciting!



In nursery we are promoting '50 things to do before you are five'. This was developed by a local nursery school and was designed to help parents support their young children's learning at home. The app is free to download and it has fantastic activity ideas!
