We will start our adventure by watching 'Mr Tumble and the minibeasts', a magical garden adventure!

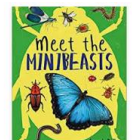
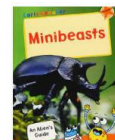
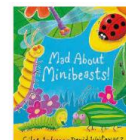
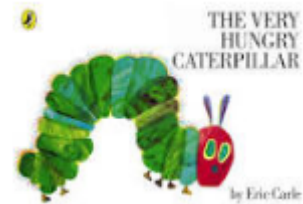
We learn some songs about different minibeasts including, 'Incy Wincy Spider', 'There's a worm at the bottom of the garden', and 'Two little snails'.

We will send a large paper leaf home for you to write about something your child has done at home so that they can share their experiences with others. We hope to make a 'Nursery Chestnut/Birch Home Tree' .



This term we will read a variety of fiction and non-fiction books about minibeasts.



In nursery we are promoting '50 things to do before you are five'. This was developed by a local nursery school and was designed to help parents support their young children's learning at home. The app is free to download and it has fantastic activity ideas!



Throughout Frizinghall Primary School, we use a programme called SCARF. The children in Nursery are chosen to be 'Star of the Day' and will receive a certificate to take home.
