

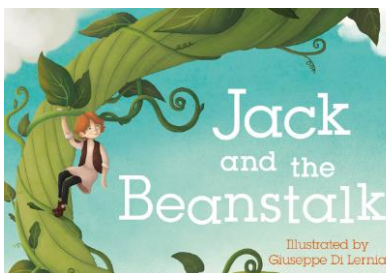
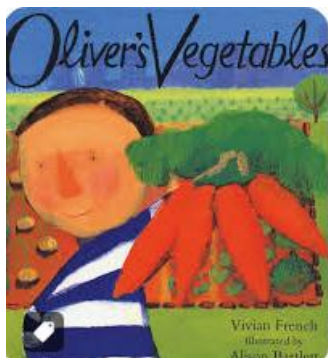
## Nursery- February-March 2026

Our fourth theme is all about growing. This half term, we will be reading stories and finding out about vegetables and how plants grow. The stories we will be reading are 'Oliver's Vegetables', which is about a boy who grows vegetables with his Granddad and 'Jack and the Beanstalk', a traditional tale about a boy who climbs up a beanstalk .



We will be planting a variety of vegetable seeds and learning how to care for them as we watch them grow.

Hopefully we will be able to plant them outside in the nursery garden and harvest them in the summer term.



We are planning a nursery trip to Lister Park to look for signs of spring towards the end of this term or early next term. Very exciting!



In nursery we are promoting '50 things to do before you are five'. This was developed by a local nursery school and was designed to help parents support their young children's learning at home. The app is free to download and it has fantastic activity ideas!
