We learn some songs about different minibeasts including, 'Incy Wincy Spider', 'There's a worm at the bottom of the garden', and 'Two little snails'.

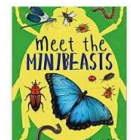
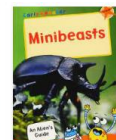
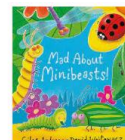
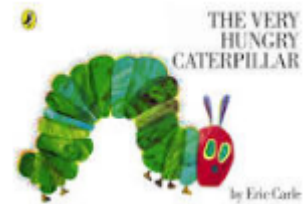


Every Thursday morning, we will be inviting parents to join our story/rhyme time session. This will be from 9.00 to 9.20. 🎵
