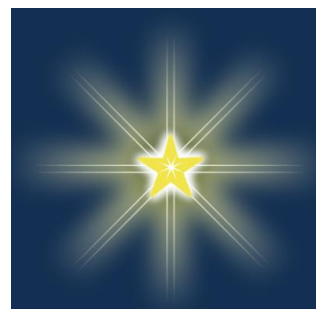
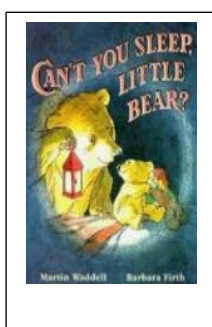


## Nursery January-February 2024
