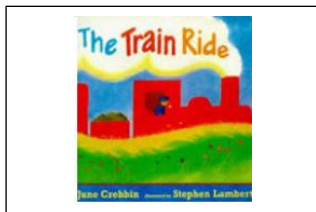

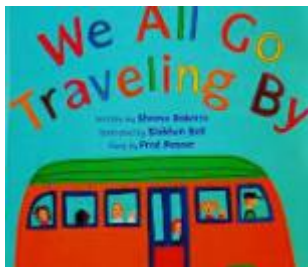
Journeys



Our sixth theme is all about journeys and transport. This half term, we will be reading stories and finding out about different forms of transport and the journeys people make. One of the stories we will be reading is 'The Train Ride' by June Crebbin. It tells the story of a little girl's journey to visit her grandma on a train and what she sees on the way.



We will also learn the song from the book, 'We all go travelling by' written by Sheena Roberts.

We will be encouraging the children to talk about the journeys they have made and about the places they have visited.
