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Dear Parents/Carers

Our first theme of the year is called 'Ourselves'. During this theme, we will be focusing on History, Geography, Science, Art and DT.

In English, we will be writing about ourselves. We will also be reading the story Beegu and writing sentences about it.

We will begin the theme with Science work. We will learn to identify, name and label parts of our bodies. We will be learning scientific skills such as asking and answering simple questions. We will also be learning about the five senses and will be using our senses to identify and classify different tastes and smells.

In History, we will be looking at how we have changed over time. We will ask children to bring photographs of themselves as babies and toddlers into school.

In Art we will be looking at self-portraits by famous artists such as Frida Kahlo. We will then draw our own self-portraits.

In Dialogic Talk sessions we will be learning to articulate and justifying our answers and opinions. For example, What is your favourite food and why?

In Geography, we will be investigating our local area and naming key features of where we live. We will be using simple fieldwork and observational skills to find out about the geography of Frizinghall.

In DT, we will be designing, making and eating a fruit kebab. We will learn to cut and chop fruit safely and correctly.

Helping at home:

As well as ensuring that your child completes their weekly homework and reads their reading books with you, you could:

- Talk about your childhood and how things have changed. Grandparents could also take part in this conversation.
- Walk around your local area
- Use Google maps to find your street.
