Dear Parents/Carers

Year 3's next topic is called Dem Bones Dem Bones. During this theme, we will focus on science, geography and art.

As this is a science-based theme, we will be learning all about the bones in our skeleton and about the right types of nutrition for our bodies. We will carry out experiments and take measurements of our running speed and the structure and shape of the bones in our skeleton. We will also look at nutrition and its importance to our bodies. The children will also be comparing different skeletons and learn about the muscles in our body.

In English, we will be learning the poem 'The Magic Box' and writing our own verse. Then we will be writing a a non-chronological report about ancient Greece.

In maths, we will carry on using multiplication and division; we will also start learning about mass and capacity.

In PHSE, we will starting the new topic - How to keep ourselves safe. This will be done through Coram Life Education, which is the scheme of work which promotes our SCARF principles.

In geography, we will be describing and understanding key aspects of human geography. We will learn where our food comes from.

For music, we will continue to learn how to play the recorder. This term we will learn the song Three Little Birds by Bob Marley.

In oracy, we will using different strategies to build vocabulary; we will be discussing healthy diets and our body's nutritional needs.

In R.E, they will continue to explore spirituality and how it is experienced. We will continue to focus on Islam, Christianity and Judaism in our R.E. curriculum.

In computing, we will be learning about online reputations and how to send an email.

In French, children will be developing their vocabulary in words and phrases related to colours, numbers and verbs using the La Jolie resources.



In art, we will be looking at the artist Giacometti and creating human body sculptures in his style.

In PE, our focus will be football and gymnastics.

For our passport activities, we will be playing cards and we will be visiting a museum!
