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Dear Parents/Carers,

Our next theme in Year 4 is called 'Planet in Danger'. During this theme, we will be focusing on science where we will be looking at living things and their habitats. We will also be looking at how living things can be grouped in a variety of ways, classification keys and how environments can change.

In English, we will be writing a portal story based on 'George's Marvellous Medicine' and moving on to a narrative adventure story using our new core text 'Charlotte's Web'.

In maths, we will be continuing with our work on decimals, recognising tenths and hundredths using place value grids and number lines. We will also be moving onto our unit of work which focuses on money.

In oracy lessons and dialogic talk sessions, we will be working on asking relevant questions to extend our understanding and knowledge. This will help enhance our learning across all subjects in terms of expressing our viewpoints.

We will also complete some of our Activity Passport challenges including making a home for a wild animal and using a camera.

During R.E. lessons, we will be continuing our work on how the Five Pillars guide Muslims. In computing, the children will be starting a new unit which will cover health, well-being and lifestyle, making music and privacy and safety online. In P.E., the children will be playing competitive games including cricket and rounders. In French, we will be looking at class management, months of the years and out and abouts. During DT lessons, we will be designing, making and evaluating our bird houses.

In P.H.S.E., we will be looking at a unit of work called 'Being my Best' linked to our SCARF values. We will also cover some online safety lessons on privacy and security.
