Dear Parents/Carers,

Our next theme in Year 4 is called 'Good Vibrations'. During this theme, we will be focusing on science where we will be identifying how sounds are made and recognising that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear.

In English, we will be finishing our persuasive travel blog linking to our core text 'Escape from Pompeii' by Christina Balit. We will then be moving on to a poetry unit looking at 'The Sound Collector'.

In maths, we will be focusing on addition measurement including length and perimeter. We will then move on to multiplication and division.

In oracy lessons and dialogic talk sessions, we will be using spoken language to develop understanding through speculating, hypothesising, imagining and exploring ideas.

We will also complete some of our Activity Passport challenges including writing and performing a poem, capturing and measuring sounds, listening to the sounds in a shell and making a string telephone.

During R.E. lessons, we will be continuing to look at how important events are remembered.

Computing lessons will focus on spreadsheets and online safety lessons will look at online relationships.

In P.E., Year 4 will be playing team games and comparing their performances with previous ones.

Our PHSE lessons will look at 'valuing difference' and then we will move on to 'keeping myself safe'.

Additionally, Year 4 are very excited to be continuing their weekly trumpet lessons on Wednesday afternoons! We will also continue our weekly French lessons focusing on parts of the body and zoo animals.
